Programs:

2nd and 3rd grade boys and girls meet Saturday mornings at **Brecknock Elementary School** from **9:00 - 11:00 a.m.** to learn the basics of playing basketball. After skills instruction, the players are split into teams to play games. Any parent or relative that would be willing to help out would be greatly appreciated. **This program will begin on Saturday, December 3rd.**

4th, 5th & 6th graders are placed onto **Boys and Girls Teams** that will practice once a week starting in December. Practices will rotate between Brecknock, New Holland and Blue Ball Elementary Schools on mostly Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays.

Games will run January through March on Saturday afternoons at Brecknock Elementary School.
